

The COVID-19 is a worldwide disaster and is a huge challenge to healthcare. From RBCZ we would like to inform you that the NUNM's (National University of Natural Medicine) Helfgott Research Institute from Portland, America has started an initiative to collect data from CAM practitioners and their anonymous clients worldwide about what is being used in therapies. at COVID-19. It is important for the CAM field that more data will be collected so that more insight can be given to other parties in the healthcare sector about what could be effective. But this data is also valuable for our own specific sector. With well-recorded case histories, case reports could possibly also be published. This is a great opportunity to share information and the RBCZ therefore calls on you to participate. Because the more data is obtained, the more reliable the results will be.

Participation is easy and I will explain how it works below.

• First enter "Yes" (assuming this is correct) in: Attestation Statement,

"I confirm the information provided here accurately reflects the course of care and outcomes for the case described". The rest is self-explanatory.

- Complete a separate form for each case. The ability to enter a different case becomes available after each submission. All questions are optional except some that provide necessary information.
- It is recommended to save the "Survey Access Code" for each case and include this code in the case. By linking this code to client file, responses can be changed if there are changes supportive care. The survey access code will be visible after you have submitted all the answers. Each case has its own unique access code, so write down each individual code and link to the respective case.
- After you have submitted a case, you will have the opportunity to download your answers as a PDF for your records.
